Bicycle policy during the 2012 Games

Non-folding bikes are not allowed at any time on London Overground trains between:

- Richmond / Clapham Junction / Willesden Junction and Stratford
- Highbury & Islington and New Cross / Forest Hill



Non-folding bikes are also not allowed Mondays to Fridays:

- Between Watford Junction and Euston on trains timed to arrive at Euston 07:00 – 10:00 and depart from Euston 16:00 – 19:00
- Between Gospel Oak and Blackhorse Road 07:00 – 10:00 and 16:00 – 19:00

Compact folding bikes are accepted on all trains at all times.
